POLICY 10.08 INFECTION CONTROL - WASTE DISPOSAL TITLE:

PURPOSE:

This policy describes managing and control of infectious waste disposal

SCOPE:

Applies to all employees, volunteers, and visitors

POLICY:

We handle and dispose of infectious was teas follows:

PROCEDURE:

At the site or room or area where you are handling infectious waste:

- 1. Bag the waste in a leak-proof bag (impervious to moisture).
- 2. Fill bag no more than 3/4 full, to allow the bag to close easily.
- 3. Clearly label the bag as "infectious waste".
- 4. Keep infectious waste separate from other waste.
- 5. Placesharps (e.g. needles or items which may cause a puncture or cut) in a rigid, puncture resistant container properly labeled and sealed.
- 6. Store bags in a closed container marked "Infectious Waste" separate from non- $\bar{infectious} was te, until was te is picked up for final disposal.$
