TITLE:	RESIDENT WANDERING	POLICY 13.02

PURPOSE:

Describes the facility's policy on wandering residents.

SCOPE:

All employees.

POLICY:

It is the policy of this facility to not accept or retain any resident that is known to wander.

PROCEDURE:

If a resident displays signs of wandering the facility will begin immediate discharge planning. The resident will be given a 30 day written notice to vacate or sooner if appropriate.

Some signs of wandering are:

- 1. Wandering into other resident's rooms.
- 2. Cannot find their way around building (lost).
- 3. Exiting outside and getting lost, etc.
- 4. Signs of confusion.

EXCEPTIONS:

No exceptions to this policy may be granted without the prior written approval of the Director.
