TITLE: MEDICATION ALTERING RESIDENTS POLICY 16.15

Authority:

WAC 388-78A-2250

WAC 246-888

PURPOSE:

Provide guidelines when having to alter a resident's medication.

SCOPE:

All nursing staff.

POLICY:

We ensure residents receive their medications in a safe and prescribed manner. At times, medications must be altered in order to aid in swallowing. This may include crushing, mixing with food or beverage, or opening a capsule.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Medications are to be provided to residents in the form in which they were prescribed by the health care practitioner and provided by the pharmacy, unless:
 - a. The resident is unable or unwilling to take the medications in their normal form; and
 - The facility has documentation from a qualified practitioner (doctor, nurse practitioner, physician's assistant, or pharmacist) that it is safe and appropriate to alter the medication in a specified manner;
 - c. The medication staff tells the resident that the medication has been altered, and the resident agrees to take the medication in the altered form.
- 2. Only trained medication staff may alter medication for resident consumption.
- 3. Document the alteration of the medication in the resident's health record, along with the appropriateness of the alteration.
