TITLE: SAFE STORAGE AND HANDLING OF SUPPLIES POLICY 23.03
AND EQUIPMENT

PURPOSE:

Describes the facility's policy in handling supplies and equipment.

SCOPE:

All employees and volunteers.

POLICY:

We ensure that all supplies and equipment, dirty and clean, are handled and stored in a safe manner, protecting residents from exposure and risk.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. When considering safe storage of supplies and equipment, the administrator and/or designee will consider at a minimum:
 - a. The assessed needs of the residents and the functional and cognitive abilities to determine what supplies and equipment may be accessible to residents
 - b. Resident characteristics and needs
 - c. The degree of hazardousness or toxicity posed by the supplies or equipment
 - d. Whether or not the supplies and equipment are commonly found in a private home (hand soap, laundry detergent, fabric softener, dishwashing soap etc)
 - e. How would residents with special needs be protected individually without unnecessary restrictions on the general population
- 2. Areas for cleaning and storing soiled equipment, supplies and laundry may be combined when:
 - a. There is a two-compartment sink for hand washing and sanitizing



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- b. A service sink or equivalent for rinsing and disposing of waste material
- c. A work counter or table
- d. Mechanical ventilation to the outside of the facility
- e. Locked storage for cleaning supplies
- f. There is no significant risk of contamination to clean or sterile nursing supplies or equipment, clean laundry, for food storage, preparation or service
- g. There is no risk of spread of infection to those who are sensitive
- h. Resident care is being performed
- 3. Areas for handling and storing clean supplies, medications, and equipment may be combined with storing clean laundry when the area is equipped with:
 - a. A hand washing sink
 - b. A work counter or table
 - c. Any work performed can be accomplished without significant risk of contamination from other sources
 - d. Medications are stored separately from all other stored items (see WAC 388-78A-2260)

EXCEPTIONS:

No exceptions to this policy may be granted without the prior written approval of the Director.
